RESIDENT PERMIT PROCESS

After we have prepared all of the require documents, we will schedule an interview for you at the consulate of the country/state in which you are located.

We will fill out all government forms, prepare you for the interview, and make sure that the document package is complete.

After receiving an immigrant visa, you will need to enter Mexico within 120 days. Afterwards, the documents will be submitted to the local immigration department for the next steps.

Within a few months you will be issued a resident card.

OPTION 1

\$2 600

Prove a monthly income of at least \$2,600.

OPTION 2

\$45 000

Prove savings of \$45,000 or more through a bank statement.

ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS

- Printing photos
- \$48 government fee
- Travel to Mexico to obtain residency card

ADDRESS

Monthly rent will allow you to obtain an address in Mexico.

BANK ACCOUNT

After receiving a residency card, you can open a bank account at any bank in Mexico.

DRIVER'S LICENSE

The process of obtaining a driver's license in Mexico is very simple for citizens who have driver's licenses from other jurisdictions.
